Chapter 175L deals with the Certificate of Insurance. Bill would create new section.

**Summary:**

Commissioner of Insurance shall maintain a database of certificates of insurance which would include person's name, insurer's name, and expiration date of policy that is open to the public. Insurer provides the information and includes name of broker if broker was used. Certificate shall contain a QR code to take you to the database.

Certificate includes number of employees employed by the certified person and estimated payroll of each employee category.

Insurer shall report to the commissioner if they suspect a customer is committing insurance fraud, workers compensation fraud, tried to avoid an investigation/audit, or engaged in a practice prohibited by this chapter. After report, commissioner would investigate case.

Gives power to commissioner to develop any regulations needed to enforce new requirements.
