Name: An Act relative to elder and medical parole

Summary:

Creates parole eligibility for prisoners aged 55 or older who have served half their sentence or 15 years, with considerations for age and health. It also establishes expedited medical parole for terminally ill or incapacitated prisoners and mandates regular assessments. The bill requires bias-free parole decisions and detailed reporting on parole outcomes.
