SUMMARY This bill provides tuition and fee waivers to Commonwealth

residents that have been under legal guardianship and live with a non-parent relative either upon reaching 18 or enrolling in a MA institution of higher learning. The Commonwealth will bear the cost of the waivers after exhaustion of federal reimbursements.

SECTION-BY-SECTION

Provides tuition and fee waivers to Commonwealth residents who have been under legal guardianship and upon reaching 18 or enrolling in a MA institution of higher learning, is living with a grandparent or other non-parent relative. The Commonwealth will bear the cost of the waivers after exhaustion of federal reimbursements.
