**Bill No.:** S682

**Title:** An Act improving access to breast pumps

**Sponsor:** Senator Cynthia Creem

**Bill History:** Favorable from JCFS, Favorable from HCF to SWM

**Hearing Date:** 4/29/2025

**Summary:** This bill would require health insurance plans to cover the monthly fees associated with renting a multi-user breast pump for mothers of infants in intensive care or special care nurseries, which serve babies born prematurely, or in need of additional medical intervention. It would also require insurers to cover the cost of replacement parts that are needed to operate the pump and an initial visit with an International Board-Certified Lactation Consultant. Requiring insurance to cover these costs will help ensure financial barriers are not preventing new mothers from providing their high-risk infants breast milk.
