JOURNAL OF THE SENATE.

Monday, February 14, 2005.

Met at five minutes past eleven o'clock A.M. (Mr. Barrios in the Chair).

The Chair (Mr. Barrios), members, guests and employees then recited the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
