Monday, February 9, 2009.

Met at two minutes past eleven o'clock A.M. (Mr. Baddour in the Chair).

The Chair (Mr. Baddour), members, guests and employees then recited the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Orders Adopted.

Mr. Brewer presented the following order, to wit:

Ordered, That a convention of the two branches be held at one o'clock P.M., on Thursday, February 12, 2009, in the House Chamber for the purpose of commemorating the two hundredth anniversary of the birth of President Abraham Lincoln.
