Monday, November 15, 2021.

Met at a quarter past eleven o'clock A.M. (Mr. Crighton in the Chair) (having been appointed by the President, under authority conferred by Senate Rule 4, to perform the duties of the Chair).

Engrossed Bills.

An engrossed Bill designating a certain bridge in the town of Needham the Private First Class David "Damon" Borrelli memorial bridge (see House, No. 3469) (which originated in the House), having been certified by the Senate Clerk to be rightly and truly prepared for final passage, was passed to be enacted and signed by the Acting President (Mr. Crighton) and laid before the Governor for his approbation.

UNCORRECTED PROOF.

September 14, 2021 and the special election held on September 21, 2021 in the town of Leicester (see House Bill, printed in House, No. 4211) (which originated in the House), having been certified by the Senate Clerk to be rightly and truly prepared for final passage, was passed to be enacted, two-thirds of the members present having voted in the affirmative, and it was signed by the Acting President (Mr. Crighton) and laid before the Governor for his approbation.

The House Bill relative to immediate COVID-19 recovery needs (House, No. 4234),-came from the House with the endorsement that the House had NON-concurred in the Senate amendment striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the text contained in Senate document numbered 2580, and had asked for a committee of conference on the disagreeing votes of the two branches; and that Representatives Michlewitz of Boston, Hunt of Boston and Smola of Warren had been appointed to the committee on the part of the House.

On motion of Mr. Fattman, the Senate insisted on its amendment and concurred in the appointment of a committee of conference; and Senators Rodrigues, Friedman and O'Connor were appointed on the part of the Senate.

The bill was returned to the House endorsed accordingly.
