The committee on Bills in the Third Reading, to whom was referred the

Engrossed Bill relative to the distribution of certain grants to regional tourism councils (see House, No. 4015) being sections 116 and 117 contained in the bill making appropriations for the fiscal year 2022 for the maintenance of the departments, boards, commissions, institutions and certain activities of the commonwealth, for interest, sinking fund and serial bond requirements and for certain permanent improvements (see House, No. 4002), which was returned by His Excellency the Governor pursuant to Article LVI with recommendation of amendment specified by him, (see Attachment O of House, No. 4019)

Reports recommending that the amendment recommended by His Excellency, the Governor, be considered in the following form:

By striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary,

grants from the amounts collected pursuant to subsection (a) of section 13T of chapter 23A of the General Laws allocated to regional tourism councils pursuant to clause (ii) of subsection (d) of said section 13T for fiscal year 2022 shall be distributed no later than September 30, 2021 pursuant to a transfer schedule determined by the executive office for administration and finance.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary,

grants from the amounts collected pursuant to subsection (b) of section 13T of chapter 23A of the General Laws allocated to regional tourism councils pursuant to clause (ii) of subsection (d) of said section 13T for fiscal year 2021 shall be distributed no later than December 30, 2021 pursuant to a transfer schedule determined by the executive office for administration and finance. SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as of July 1, 2021.".

And that when so amended the same will be correctly drawn.
