### PROVISION OF ALTERNATIVE WATER

- ► Intended for MassDEP defined Sensitive Sub-Group
- Contracted with Vendor to provide bottled water
- ► Wednesdays & Sundays Punch Card System 1400 Households
- ▶ \$22,000 weekly for water distribution at Transfer Station
- Nursing Home/Assisted Living/Day Care \$14,000 monthly
- Rebate Program Currently 625 Households \$20,000 monthly
- Considering Water Vending Stations \$5,000 per unit monthly
- Staff Engagement Customer Relations
- Municipal Needs: Financial Assistance
