Department of Public Utilities Unified Carrier Registration Trust Fund

Between October 13, 2021 and October 12, 2022, the Department of Public Utilities collected \$2,290,875.00 in revenue and expended \$2,558,600.98 from the Unified Carrier Registration Trust Fund, starting with the FY2022 reported balance of \$1,605,332.36. The Unified Carrier Registration Trust Fund currently has an unexpended balance of \$1,337,606.38.

The spending from the Unified Carrier Registration Trust is to fund the payroll and administration costs, including vehicle, office supplies, travel, and reimbursements for ten full-time staff to administer the Federal Unified Carrier Registration program, as well as enforcement activities in conjunction with the Massachusetts State Police.
