Department of Public Utilities Unified Carrier Registration Trust Fund

Between October 13, 2022, and November 21, 2023, the Department of Public Utilities collected \$2,933,470.66 in revenue and expended \$2,488,792.36 from the Unified Carrier Registration Trust Fund, starting with the FY2023 reported balance of \$1,337,606.38. The Unified Carrier Registration Trust Fund currently has an unexpended balance of \$1,782,284.68.

The spending from the Unified Carrier Registration Trust is to fund the payroll and administration costs, including vehicle, office supplies, training, travel, and reimbursements for fourteen full-time staff to administer the Federal Unified Carrier Registration program, as well as enforcement activities in conjunction with the Massachusetts State Police.
