## Admissions:

**Pre-Trial/Detainees** - Includes awaiting trial, US Marshall detainees, incarcerated individuals held on bail, bail violators, hold for other jurisdiction, fugitive from justice, failure to pay costs/fine, pre-arraignment

**Criminally Sentenced** - Includes new court commitments (commitment from court, from and after sentence, split sentence) and re-admissions (parole violators, probation violators, transfers, return from escape, re-admit from court release)

## **Releases:**

**Pre-Trial/Detainees -** Includes awaiting trial, US Marshall detainees, incarcerated individuals held on bail, bail violators, hold for other jurisdiction, fugitive from justice, failure to pay costs/fine, pre-arraignment

**Criminally Sentenced** - Includes new court commitments (commitment from court, from and after sentence, split sentence) and re-admissions (parole violators, probation violators, transfers, return from escape, re-admit from court release)

## **Caseload Snapshot:**

**Pre-Arraignment -** Includes incarcerated individuals housed in a State or County facility prior to being arraigned, including "regional lock-up"

**Pre-Trial/Detainees -** Includes awaiting trial, US Marshall detainees, incarcerated individuals held on bail, bail violators, hold for other jurisdiction, fugitive from justice, failure to pay costs/fine, pre-arraignment

**Criminally Sentenced** - Includes new court commitments (commitment from court, from and after sentence, split sentence) and re-admissions (parole violators, probation violators, transfers, return from escape, re-admit from court release)

## Recidivism:

**New Commitments** - Includes criminally sentenced individuals committed by the courts to State or County Corrections as a result of a criminal offense

**Violations** - Includes individuals re-admitted as a result of a violation of probation or parole returning to a State or County prison, inlcuding technical violations. Technical violations are not necessarily the result of administrative conditions of parole, and could include uncharged criminal conduct or conduct that is under criminal investigation
