

#### Dear Sheriff Cahillane:

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health (Department) Division of Environmental Health Regulations and Standards (EHRS) conducted an inspection of the Hampshire County Jail and House of Correction, Pre-Release Center, on March 18, 2025, accompanied by Lieutenant Jason Graham, Compliance Officer, in accordance with Department regulations 105 CMR 451.000: Minimum Health and Sanitation Standards and Inspection Procedures for Correctional Facilities.

The inspection identified 3 total deficiencies: 1 new deficiency under the Required Standards (.100 and .200 series), 1 new deficiency under the Recommended Standards (.300 series), and 1 repeat deficiency under the Recommended Standards.

#### Overview

Section 1 provides details of all deficiencies, including repeat deficiencies, found during the inspection. These are categorized by Required Standards, Recommended Standards, or additional applicable regulatory standards.

#### **SECTION 4: Plan of Correction**

This facility does not comply with the Department's Regulations cited above. In accordance with 105 CMR 451.404, please submit a plan of correction within 10 working days of receipt of this notice. The Plan of Correction must include:

- 1. Specific corrective steps to be taken
- 2. A timetable for the corrective actions for larger projects
- 3. The date by which correction will be achieved
- 4. Any interim measures being implemented to ensure the health and safety of incarcerated individuals and facility staff
- 5. The plan should be signed by the Superintendent or Administrator and submitted to my attention, at the address listed above.

#### **SECTION 4: Observations and Recommendations**

- 1. The inmate population was 5 at the time of inspection.
- 2. Hot water temperature range for handwash sinks is 110°F 130°F.
- 3. Hot water temperature range for showers is 100°F 112°F.
