

To the Honorable House and Senate Clerks:

Chapter 239 Section 125 of the Massachusetts 2024 Session Laws required the Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs to review existing flood risk mapping resources and assess the need for and feasibility of creating additional flood risk mapping resources to identify areas vulnerable to current and future flooding across the commonwealth. We were also asked to submit recommendations, including any legislation or funding necessary, to support any additional required flood risk mapping resources.
