As required by 1599-2040 of Section 2B Chapter 46 of the Acts of 2015, the Office of the Comptroller is submitting this report on Prior Year Deficiencies, to the House and Senate Committees on Ways and Means.

The attached Paid Prior Year Deficiency Report contains information regarding payment of prior year deficiencies through chargebacks to FY2016 funds.

Through the second quarter of FY2016, details attached, a total of \$9,550,579 was spent in prior year deficiencies for 29 departments. Of that, \$658,771 was incurred in accounts that had sufficient funds and \$8,891,808 was from accounts that had insufficient funds.
