As required by 1599-2040 of Section 2B Chapter 133 of the Acts of 2016, the Office of the Comptroller is submitting this report on Prior Year Deficiencies, to the House and Senate Committees on Ways and Means.

The attached Paid Prior Year Deficiency Report contains information regarding payment of prior year deficiencies through chargebacks to FY2017 funds.

Through the third quarter of FY2017, details attached, a total of \$11,223,963.79 was spent in prior year deficiencies for 42 departments. Of that, \$1,774,368 was incurred in accounts that had sufficient funds and \$9,449,596 was from accounts that had insufficient funds.
