I had mentioned to Roxanne that these work items should not be worked at this time. There are way too many problems with them. Any OOS conviction info really needs to be handled by the SPEXS team as there are just too many AAMVA rules involved in what needs to be present and in what format.

In the case below, Atlas should not have accepted the H3 message containing the conviction info as it was missing the offense reference for two of the offenses (If I drill down into the AAMVA messaging I can see that). We should have kicked it back to VA with an error. I have asked FAST to fix this as this is the other State's responsibility to correct.
