Dear Mr. Welch,

Enclosed please find proposed regulation changes to 205 CMR 3.00 and 4.00, regulations governing Harness Horse Racing and Running Horse Racing, pursuant to M.G.L. c.128A, §9B. These proposed new rules do several important things for the industry including repealing the current regulation which permits the use of a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory medication on racedays, providing a split sample provision to afford owners and trainers additional due process protection in the event of an alleged medication violation, preventing the transfer of horses in a suspended trainer's care to his or her spouse during the period of suspension, and providing clear withdrawal times for accepted therapeutic medications to veterinary practitioners and trainers in the form of treatment restriction windows.
