The committee on Bills in the Third Reading, to whom was referred the

engrossed Bill authorizing the town of Burlington to grant additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises (see House, No. 3676), which was returned by His Excellency the Governor with recommendation of amendment specified by him (for message see House, No. 4286),

Reports recommending that the amendment recommended by His Excellency, the Governor, be considered in the following form:

In section 1 of the engrossed bill striking out subsection (e) and inserting in place thereof the following subsection:

(e) Any license granted pursuant to this act shall be issued not later than 5 years after the effective date of this act; provided, however, that a license originally granted within that time period may be granted to a new applicant pursuant to subsection (c) or (d) thereafter.

And that when so amended the same will be correctly drawn.
