

An Act financing improvements to municipal roads and bridges

An Act financing improvements to municipal roads and bridges includes a total of \$375 million in bond authorization. Every city and town in the Commonwealth would receive a share of \$200 million in funding to be used on maintenance and construction of roads and bridges.

This bill was signed into law by Governor Healey on 5/3/2024.

Highlights

- 1 The bill earmarks \$200 million specifically for the repair and improvement of municipal roads, which are crucial for urban and suburban transportation.
- 2 The bill allocates \$25 million each to several transportation infrastructure programs, including the Municipal Pavement Program, the Rural Roadway Funding Program, the Municipal Small Bridge Program, the Complete Streets Funding Program, the Municipal Bus Enhancement Program, the Mass Transit Access Grant Program, and the Municipal/Regional Transit Authority (RTA) Electric Vehicle (EV) Grant Program
